SI. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 12. Any further increase of section shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	The school has made provision for CWSN toilets; however only two CWSN toilets each for boys and girls were seen in the inspection videography. The school is required to make provision of separate toilets for CWSN students (for boys and girls) on every floor with proper possible infrastructural facilities in accordance with the provisions laid down in RPwD Act 2016 and submit videographic proof of toilets within 3 months on the SARAS portal.
3	The ramp shown in the inspection video appears to be steep, hence considered to be dangerous from the safety point of view of the CWSN students. The school shall dismantle the same and construct a ramp or lift as prescribed by the RPwD Act 2016 and Circular No. 5 dated 06.03.2023 issued by the Board and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on the SARAS portal.
4	Library shown in the inspection video does not have separate reading space for the staff. The school is required to upgrade the Library in light of the SOPs issued by the board and submit videographic proof within 3 months on the SARAS portal undersized
5	There is no seating arrangement in the Mathematics lab, thus the school is required to make adequate seating arrangement and submit videographic proof within 3 months

	on the SARAS portalunder equipped
6	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Bhubaneswar within 3 months and submit the compliance.
7	The school shall upgrade the composite lab as per SoP issued by the board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	The Building Safety Certificate uploaded by the school does not have the details of the all blocks & no. of floors. Hence school is required to obtain fresh building safety certificate exactly as per Appendix-XI and submit the compliance through videography within 3 months on the SARAS portal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/-every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.

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- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.
